Speaking on the roll-out of the card to all FNB customers, FNB Product Development Manager, Celani Dlamini said, "In as much as the bank would want to roll out the cards to all customers at once, we have a large customer base and would not want to negatively impact their experience by a once-off roll out. In addition, we are also aware of the current travel and social distancing restrictions implemented to keep Eswatini safe in the fight against COVID-19, hence we are staggering the release of contactless cards and confining issuance to customers opening new accounts and those replacing expiring cards.".

Dlamini also encouraged customers to not wait until the last minute to replace their cards to avoid waiting in queues on the last day of the month. To this end, he said that SMS notifications are being sent to customers before their cards expire which also prompts them to get their new 'cool-card' so they can Tap-to-Pay.
